



DESCRIPTION

- a non-caustic paint stripper for timber

PRINCIPAL CHARACTERISTICS

- low-viscosity, economical, and will not darken timber. May be used as a tank-immersion stripper for larger items, such as chairs
- removes French polish, varnish, lacquers and other conventional coatings from timber surfaces requiring subsequent re-finishing

Note: We advise that you must test this product to determine if it is suitable for your particular use.

COLOUR AND GLOSS

- not applicable

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- paint onto the surface freely with an old brush, or use a dip tank
- allow the film to soften thoroughly before removing with a scraper - if the stripper is left on for too long, the surface will re-harden
- scrub surface with a steel-wool pad soaked in a mixture of equal parts Wattyl T10 Thinner and T35 Thinner
- wash the surface with several applications of this mixture, and allow to dry thoroughly before re-finishing

Note: Because of the product's low viscosity, always try to apply it to horizontal surfaces for the best effect. Care should be taken when dipping, as it may weaken glued joints.

- shelf life (cool and dry place) at least 12 months in unopened containers
