



DESCRIPTION

- an oil based finish for Kwila and similar timbers

PRINCIPAL CHARACTERISTICS

- a penetrating clear which acts to preserve and rejuvenate new and aged timbers
- it will enhance the natural appearance of raw timbers
- ideally suited for use on sheltered outdoor furniture such as timber barbeques, pot plant holders, etc.

Note: We advise that you test this product to determine if it is suitable for your particular use.

COLOUR AND GLOSS

- clear, oiled appearance

BASIC DATA AT 25° C and 50% RELATIVE HUMIDITY

- touch dry..... 2 hours. However this is largely dependant on the natural porosity of the timber
- full dry 1-2 days
- shelf life (cool and dry place) at least 12 months (unopened containers)

SURFACE PREPARATION

- all surfaces must be free from wax, silicone, oil and other contaminants
- if required, sand timber to obtain the desired surface finish

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- agitate thoroughly with a flat-bladed stirrer before and during use
- thinning not required
- clean up with T10 Thinner
- apply to raw timbers or over itself
- work well into the surface, rubbing along the grain of the timber
- remove any excess with a clean, dry cloth to leave a thin layer of protective wax
- can also be applied with fine-grade steel wool, rubbing length-wise along the grain, and wiping off with a clean, dry cloth, as above
- the wax allows a smooth feel to the surface and may takes some days to dry
- for recommendations outside those contained in this data sheet, refer to Watty!
